



COMMIT TO CAMP EARLY THIS YEAR ... and increase your salary! Avoid the stress of back-and-forth thinking (Do I return to camp? Do I explore the world of retail or filing?) and decide to join the fantastic Kayitz 2018 team right away!

This year we are offering three early signing incentives:

1. Staff that signed the "Intent to Return" on Yom Vayinafash make sure to submit your application by NOVEMBER 6th, as that was part of the agreement. You will receive a \$50 bonus upon returning for kayitz 2018.

2. Staff that submit their application by NOVEMBER 6th and return as staff this kayitz will qualify for a \$50 bonus (even if you did not sign "Intent to Return)."

3. Staff that sign and return their contract within SEVEN days of receipt, and return as staff this kayitz will qualify for a \$50 bonus. This opportunity will expire at the end of February.



JEWISH EDUCATION STIPEND

CALLING ALL COLLEGE-AGE TZEVET!

In efforts to promote Jewish learning among our COLLEGE-AGE STAFF, Camp Ramah in California is proud to offer 2018 tzevet the opportunity to obtain up to \$100 towards post-high school Jewish learning. These stipends will be given to high school graduates who enroll in a college-level course in Judaic Studies or Hebrew Language, or who spend a semester or year in Israel.

Eligible college-age staff members will receive up to \$100 added to their summer salary. Please be prepared to submit a camp form describing your course or time in Israel for approval by March 31st!



CALLING ALL 5TH, 6TH AND 7TH YEAR TZEVET!



The New Machon created the opportunity to revamp what it means to be on Tzevet Machon and created new leadership roles to help prepare you for potential senior leadership opportunities in or out of camp.

Morei Derech - These are the educators that will be an integral part of the Machon tzevet, guiding, educating, mentoring as senior educators, but also participate in the daily Machon events and be a part of the tzevet. They will also ideally live in the Machon living quarters so they can be accessible to the Machonies throughout the day and week.

—> Educators will lead Mishkan: engaging study sessions where Machonies will grapple with a range of topics such as leadership, personalities, relationships, bodily and mental wellness, prayer, God, and Jewish identity all through the lenses of Torah and contemporary psychology, all while learning how to bring what they have learned into their everyday lives. Mishkan is a nexus for self-reflection through communal exploration.

Machon Madrichim/ot— Being a single madrich/a in a chavura allows you the chance to be the sole person working to influence, challenge, guide and inspire a group of 10-12 Machonies as they become more independent.

- —> Jump into the next role of leadership & be challenged in new settings/situations different from your previous role as a madrich.
- -> Serve as an educator helping lead some of Mishkan, help "produce" big projects such as Maccabiah, Tiyul Gibush, Tzaadah, etc.




CORNERSTONE FELLOWSHIP

For many of us, the outside pressures of needing other work experience can often prevent us from returning to camp year after year on tzevet. However, now, with the help of our partners, we are able to offer our Internship in Partnership (IIP) program. IIP allows you to gain work experience in other fields in the weeks leading up to camp before returning for another summer on tzevet. After you apply for IIP, we match you with an internship in a field that interests you. Over the past few years we've offered our staff members notable internships in entertainment, production, and journalism. A generous stipend will be added to your salary for participating in IIP.

- Train Staff on matbe'ah and nusach, meaning & pronunciation of t'fillot as needed
- Support Chanichim on nusach, meaning & pronunciation of t'fillah
- Model Leadership by leading t'fillah and demonstrating good hazanut
- Coordinate Torah/Haftorah Readings recruit Torah and Haftorah readers as needed

Rakazim will participate in pre-summer planning for their work through meetings and/or phone conferences. Rakazim who are also madrichim will be assigned to work with their edah.

**RETURNING FOR KAYITZ 2018:

After a successful third year, we are continuing our year-round t'fillah training track to improve t'fillot and to strengthen the role of the Shlichei Tzibor in Camp. Participants will attend a training program or online training (dates TBD) and receive a stipend of \$350 for year round and summer work.
